Mibugawa Power Company holds completion ceremony for  
Mibugawa No. 1 and No. 2 Power Stations

Marubeni Corporation's fully-owned subsidiary, Mibugawa Power Company ("Mibugawa"), held a ceremony in Ina City, Nagano prefecture on July 15 to commemorate the completion of Mibugawa No.1 and No. 2 Power Stations ("the Plants") which resumed commercial operation in December 2014 (No.2 Power Station) and in May 2016 (No.1 Power Station), respectively.

Mibugawa replaced the Plants, which they have operated for more than 50 years, and will operate them on a permanent basis. The Plants are expected to produce approximately 180 million kWh per annum – corresponding to the annual power consumption of approximately 50,000 ordinary houses. The generated power will be sold to Marubeni Power Retail Corporation to utilize in its power retail business.

Mibugawa conducts stable operation of small hydro power plants on a nationwide scale by utilizing its operational know-how. Mibugawa will accumulate experience and technical strength through the operation of these state-of-the-art Plants which will contribute to the development of hydro power plants in the future. Mibugawa will therefore continuously work on the construction of hydro power plants on a nationwide scale and contribute to local communities.

Mibugawa began operation of hydro power plants in 1963 and currently operates 15 hydro power plants (six plants in Nagano, three plants in Yamanashi, three plants in Fukushima, three plants in Hiroshima). Mibugawa will proactively work on the production of renewable energy in Japan and aims to develop around 30 small- and medium-sized hydro power plants by 2020.
